Online Emergency Responder Education Program

Enbridge is proud to offer public safety and emergency officials in our areas of operation FREE, unlimited access to our Emergency Responder Education Program available at mypipelinetraining.com.

The program is designed to provide local emergency responders with the information they need to safely and effectively respond to a pipeline emergency.

The online training program takes approximately 4.5 hours to complete and features interactive, 3-D graphics to help emergency responders better visualize a response to pipeline incidents.

The content is based on Pipeline Emergencies, an industry-leading pipeline emergency response training program developed by the U.S. National Association of State Fire Marshals (NASFM). The program material was adapted to provide information specific to pipelines operated by Enbridge.

The program includes information about:

- Liquids and natural gas gathering and transmission pipeline operations
- Common products transported and their associated hazards
- Pipeline emergency response tactics, including the Incident Command System
- Real-life scenarios



9-1-1 dispatchers and call takers can also access role-specific training at mypipelinetraining.com. The 1-hour 9-1-1 Dispatch Module was developed in partnership with the National Emergency Number Association and provides information on how to identify a pipeline emergency, relay appropriate information to callers and initiate a safe response.

The online training program can be completed in one session or in multiple sessions. A wallet card and certificate are provided upon completion. In the U.S., this program may qualify for the following:

- Continuing education credits
- OSHA HAZMAT compliance
- Emergency Medical Services Training
- Insurance Service Office Fire Suppression Rating Schedule Program
